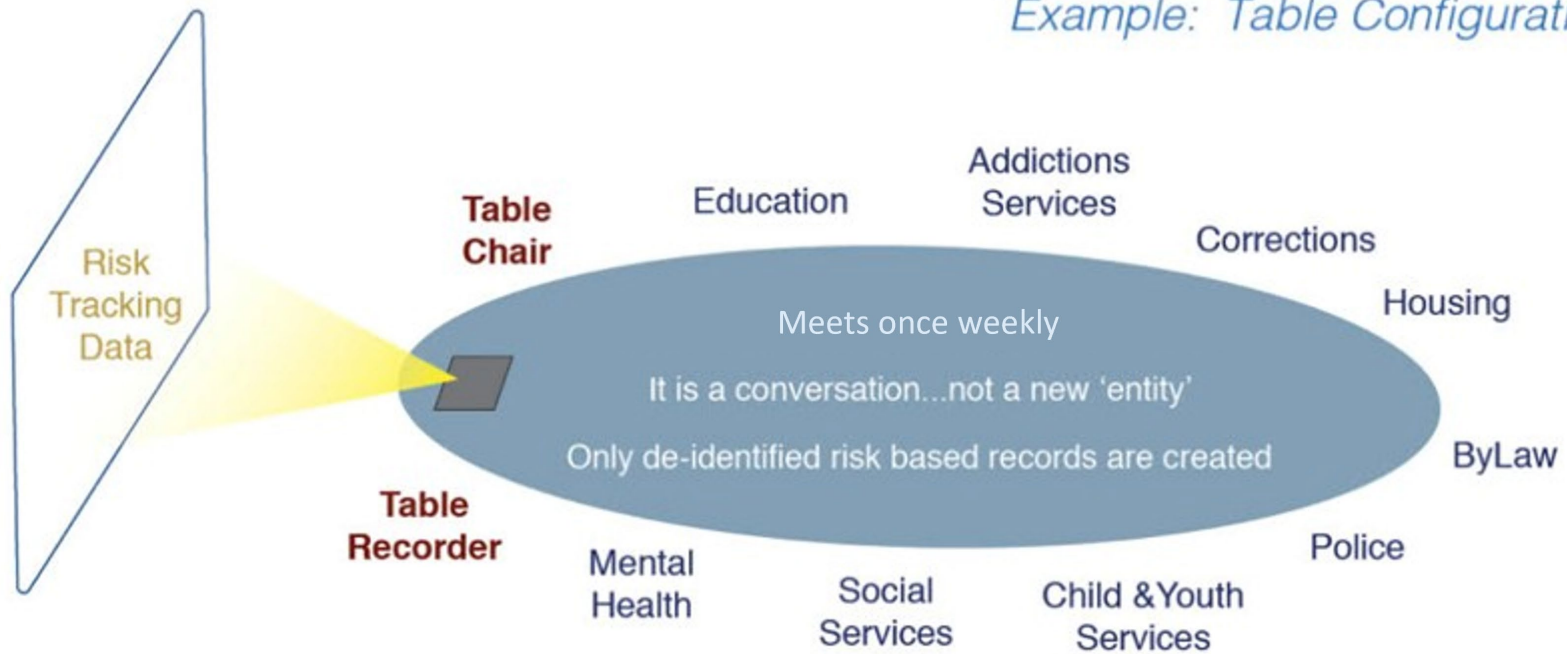

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Key Aspects of the Situation Table

- Uses the 4 Filter Process
- Operates with Consensus
- It is a Triage Model that Mobilizes Multi-agency Supports
- Success for a Situation Is a Connection to Services
- It is not a new entity, but rather a Carefully Disciplined Conversation
- New Tool for Human Service Professionals
- Focus is on Offering Support, it is **not** an Enforcement Model

One of the most important concepts driving the creation of, and continuing need for, the Situation Table is this idea of

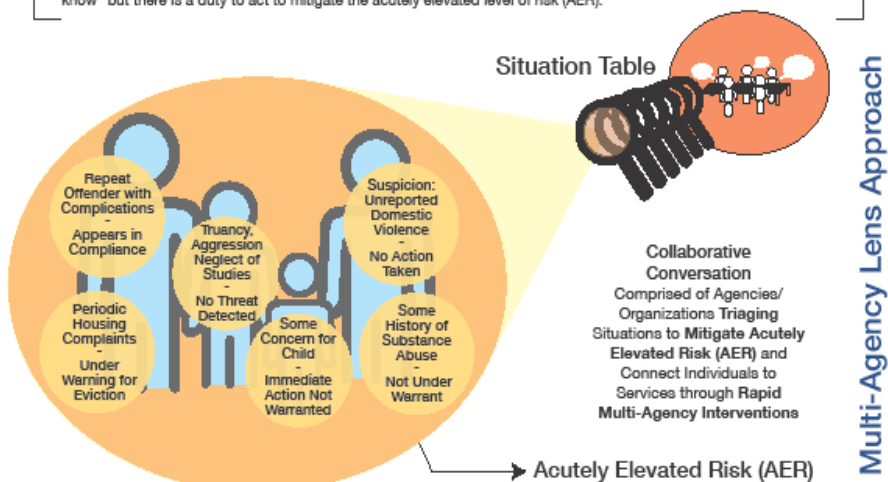
“We Don’t Know What We Don’t Know:



[We don't know what we don't know](#)
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- Each individual agency has a specific lens into an individual or family's set of risk factors, and a specific tool to determine the level of those risks. (Bi/Tri-lateral collaborations may also occur broadening that lens to some degree). On their own each they may assess the risk of a situation to be low or in-hand based on the limited information available and their specific assessment tools.
- In some cases, however, an agency or collaboration may not be aware of additional increasing risks at play in a situation outside of their scope and mandate. A client might not disclose all information for a number of reasons, or might not even recognize the risks that are present given their situation.
- In these cases, an agency or small collaboration, might recognize an individual/family's situation is worsening at a rapid rate to severe levels, despite their efforts to address the needs in their scope.
- The Situation Table is designed to address these situations, where "We don't know what we don't know" but there is a duty to act to mitigate the acutely elevated level of risk (AER).

Ensuring access to training and support

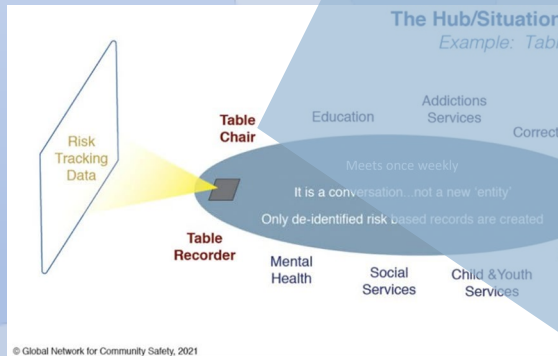
Liaising with the System Leaders Group

Facilitating and leading the pace and cadence of the Situation Table meeting flow



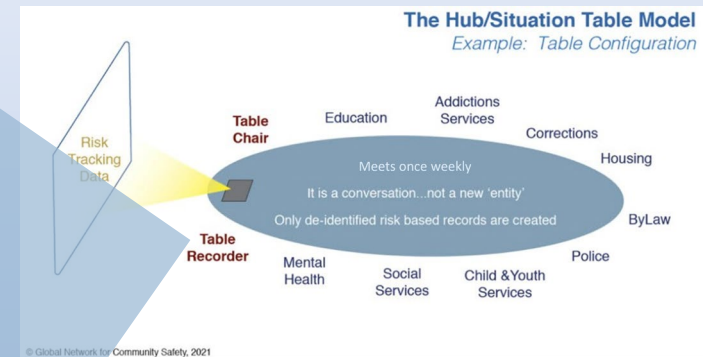
The Anatomy of a Table – Table Roles

Table (Data) Recorder

Two individuals identified and trained for this role, in case the primary individual is unavailable

Attending the weekly meetings and using the Situation Table Solution to enter the pre-determined de-identified variables

Possess some proficiency with Excel program



Data Recorder-Situation Table Solution

Responsible for updating, tracking situations in the Situation Table Solution

Typically, the Situation Table Solution is displayed to Table Participants during each meeting

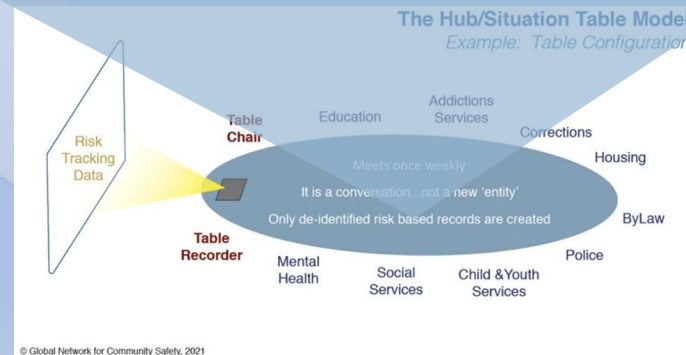
The Anatomy of a Table – Table Roles

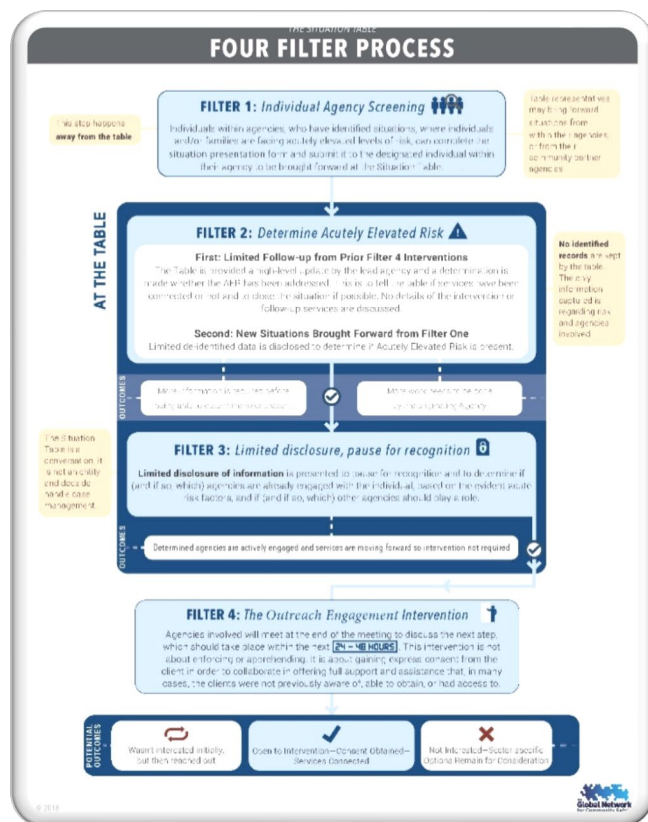
