Why Situational Awareness is Important?

For the personal safety of you, your co-responder teammate(s) and all those present at an outreach engagement

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For the benefit of those you are engaging

- Provides you with the best line of defense for situations where safety could be a concern
- Pre-incident indicators, red flags are identified
- Gives you the ability to formulate a plan for action at outreach engagements, in advance, or as it occurs
